

- Official Statement RE role of sober monitor
 - Who is a sober monitor (informed beforehand):
 - Executive Board members must volunteer as a sober monitor at least once per semester. There must be a minimum of three sober monitors per social event. One of these sober monitors will act as the bartender to limit the consumption of alcohol.
 - Role of Sober Monitor
 - Not just to monitor safe drinking but also to be of assistance to anyone feeling uncomfortable
 - YOU CANNOT DRINK ALCOHOL AS A SOBER MONITOR.
 - One sober monitor as a bartender, one stationed by the door to give drink tickets and ensure no one leaves the party too intoxicated, and one patrolling the party
 - How do we best share with our members who the designated sober monitors are?
 - Red sash that says sober monitor (4x)

- Alcohol Policies
 - 3 drink tickets per person, which will be given when entering the party.
 - Social-Marketing/Sober monitors serve as bartending support
 - Table with non-alcoholic beverages including LOTS of water bottles
 - Do not need to have drink tickets for this. Separate from the bartender.
 - Additional table with plenty of high carb or protein and low fat and low salt snacks
 - Table must include serving utensils, plates and napkins.
